### When was G20 established?

G20 was established in 1999 to bring together finance ministers and central bank Governors of developed and developing countries for the economic development of the world.. The Group of Twenty (G20) comprises Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, United Kingdom and United States and the European Union. The G20 members represent around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the global trade, and about two-thirds of the world population.

### What is the significance of G-20 , 2023 summit logo Lotus?

The G20 Logo Lotus draws inspiration from the vibrant colors of India's National Flag – saffron, white and green, and blue. It juxtaposes planet Earth with the Lotus, India's National Flower that reflects growth amid challenges. The Earth reflects India's **pro-planet approach to life, one in perfect harmony with nature.**
