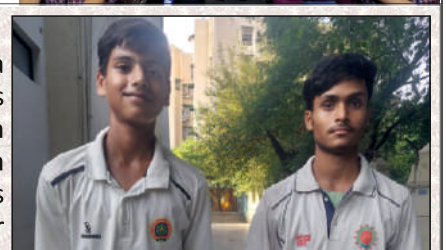


From School Ground to State Glory
