If you miss the first buttonhole, you will not succeed in buttoning up your coat.

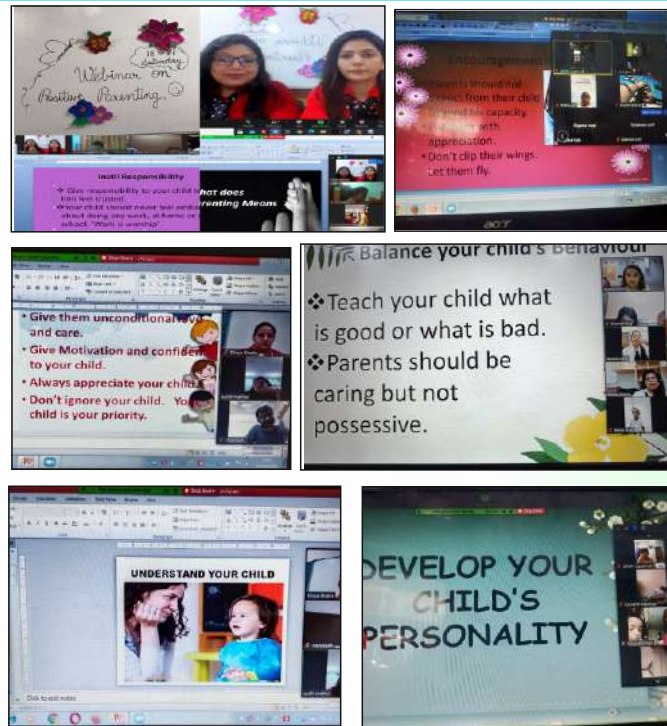


WEBINAR - Environmental Awareness

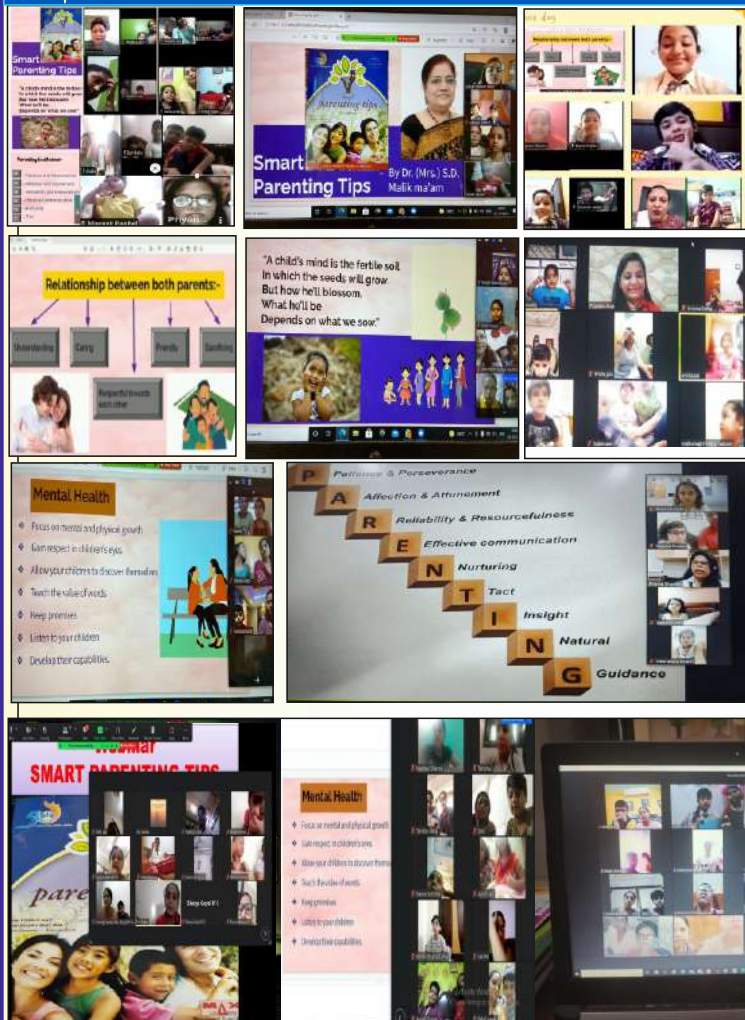

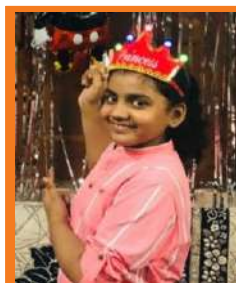
